### **Brother Rice School honored**

For the second year in a row, Brother Rice High School has been named to the Catholic High School Honor Roll, which lists the nation's top 50 Catholic high schools.

The all-boys school with 1,200 students in Chicago's Mount Greenwood community also placed in the top 20 for its Catholic identity and academics. The third category of judging is civic education.

More than half of the schools are repeat performers from last year. Five Illinois schools were named to the list, but Brother Rice was the only Southland school in the top 50.

St. Rita High School, 7740 S. Western Ave., was a category leader for Catholic identity.
